Striking a single line can cause injury, repair costs, fines and inconvenient outages. Every digging project, no matter how large or small, warrants contacting Indiana 811 beforehand.

Rate review request filed to meet **future reliability** and **customer needs**

On June 28, AES Indiana filed a petition for a regulatory rate review request with the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission (IURC) to seek a rate increase to cover the rising operational costs and needs associated with serving customers safely and reliably.



Do you want to know how the rate increase will affect your bill? Use our bill calculator to see the potential impact.

1. Go to www.aesindiana.com/rate-review. Make sure you have your latest bill available. You'll need that information to estimate your monthly increase.
2. Put in your rate code, listed under “Metered Electric and Other Services” next to “rate”.
3. Input your monthly kilowatt (kWh) hour usage, found under “Historical Usage.” Input your current period for a more accurate reading.
4. Click “Calculate” and your estimated increase will automatically populate.

Pending approval from the IURC, new rates are anticipated to go into effect the summer of 2024. If rates are approved, AES Indiana expects to remain among the lowest residential rates.
